Las/Lailps type 3-axle articulated tarpaulin wagons

The 3-axle articulated wagons with sliding tarpaulin type Las, later Lails/Lailps, were built from 1974 onwards by SNAV in collaboration with EVS on the basis of the chassis of a 3-axle car transport wagon already built by SNAV itself. Initially they were purchased by EVS (France) and Indesit (Italy), later also by Transfesa (Spain) - in the version with variable-gauge axles introduced in 1976 - and by Ausiliare Milano (Italy). In the following years further sub-series with small variations were delivered. In the course of time, some of these wagons were also leased or sold to other companies, with corresponding changes of logos.

They are still used today for transporting large palletised goods that must be transported out of the weather and require a large manoeuvring space to be loaded, either in homogeneous compositions or in isolated units together with wagons of other types.
