Dear Member,

As you'll see we are still a relatively small company, but our club membership in our three years of trading has gone from 2,000 members in year one, to 5,000 members in year two, and at the end of July it was up to 7,000. We must be doing something right as they say!

We have also included an edited replica of the 'final' programme and a 10 x 8 photograph of the victorious team holding the World Cup aloft.

Dating from approximately 1920 to its closedown in the late sixties, the Royal Bucks Laundry was an institution. Its beautiful Dutch girl logo made the vans an eye catcher all over the area.

Sadly both laundries and their buildings are no longer in Chesham or High Wycombe, but as a poignant memorial, the original ceramic tiled emblem of the Dutch girl has been built into the wall of the new building where the Royal Bucks Laundry in High Wycombe once stood.

Oxford Die-Cast have had this plaque photographed for our members and on the reverse is a special certificate
