NEW FACTORY '98

THOSE OF our members who experienced delays in January and February might have wondered why!

Well here's the reason - we have a new factory in Neath, South Wales - about 10 miles from the last manufacturing plant.

We couldn't tell you before as we were endeavouring to keep it a secret from our competitors. Though they did find out and would have you believe we had gone out of business!

There is a special commemorative vehicle (see page 4) available in this issue to mark the occasion. The edition is only 2600 pieces - see back cover. Tell your friends and family about ODC. We'll welcome them to our club! (page 4)

THE FACTS

- The factory is approximately 30,000 square feet in size.
- It took 3 weeks to move all the machinery using heavy haulage contractors - with police escort!
- We will be handling a lot more product from this site - in particular promotional offers, ie. 'In the Shops' deals etc.
- Its 5 minutes from junction 43 on the M4.
- We believe we are one of the only manufacturers of die-cast vehicles operating solely from the U.K. as most other die-cast products are now part or fully Far East manufactured.

Phew! What a couple of months it's been, keeping our new set up a secret. Fortunately it hasn't been as disruptive as we thought. Two or three models from the last issue of 'Globe' got held up - 'Chesham Dairies' and 'Bucks Examiner' - but I understand they should now be available.

Hopefully with the new streamline set up our production capacity should increase considerably. We've also found some 'desirables' in the move and I've asked for them to be released to you - (see page 3).

To mark the occasion of our move we've launched a superb special commemorative vehicle - and what better than the Bullnose - which was the first O.D.C. vehicle - to celebrate with (see page 4).

The wheels problem on the Chevy now seems resolved and the Norbert Dentressangle pantechnicon (C002) is the first Chevrolet production vehicle to be released on behalf of a company (available at the end of April).

There are also several new models in the pipeline which will enhance the range considerably, and we hope to launch two new ones this year.

We seem to be doing a lot of meat products - New Zealand Lamb, Brains Faggots, Danepak, and the gorgeous Bovril duo.

Shortly we will commence with a further 6 part special set of War Time vehicles with our U.S. members in mind.

new factory in Neath we are introducing a small edition of just 2600 special vans to commemorate the opening (1000 available to members).

The factory which is about 30,000 square feet will manufacture from scratch - from the smelting of the zinc along with the spraying and printing to the assembly of each vehicle.

From production the finished vehicle will move through quality control into the packing department to be boxed with its certificate of authenticity.

Finally it will go to dispatch for packing into outer cartons ready for mailing to the customer.

The orders will still be processed at our offices in Tring where all customer information is stored.

This special commemorative vehicle is manufactured from the Bullnose range and as it

is unique, we anticipate it will be highly sought after.
