# Fremlins Brewery

Drinks labels - in particular those for beer, have often been enlarged to use as advertisements. A superb example of this is with the 'Fremlins Brewery' which we have chosen as the livery for our members only vehicle.

It was actually known as 'Elephant Brand Ale' and first appeared in the 1920's.

Printed labels were first used in the early 1840's and some Breweries were worried that some customers, after drinking the ale were refilling the empty bottles and selling them on again! It was not uncommon for brewers to add the following to their labels – "When empty please destroy the label."

This vehicle is being used in the U.K. and U.S. as a promotional vehicle and sent to breweries worldwide. The edition is 10,000 pieces.

# 50th Birthday

To commemorate the 50th birthday of H.R.H. Prince of Wales, this delightful 'royal blue' Bullnose Model No 156 is commissioned with an edition of just 4000 pieces.

Charles was born to the Queen, then Princess Elizabeth at 9.14pm November 14th 1948 at Buckingham Palace.

He was christened at the palace on 15th December 1948.

His schooling (outside of the palace) began in 1957 at Hill House School as a day pupil, but within a few months he was moved to Cheam prep as a boarder.

In 1962 he went on to Gordonstoun in Scotland where he boarded like his father before him. At Gordonstoun he was made head boy.

In 1966 he headed for Melbourne in Australia where he joined Timbertop for 2 terms

As heir to the throne he is afforded the highest royal status - 'The Prince of Wales' which was bestowed upon him at his investiture at Caernarvon Castle in Wales on 1st July 1969 by H.R.H the Queen.

Known as 'action man' Charles is a pilot of both aircraft and helicopters as well as becoming a Naval Officer in command of his own ship - 'HMS Bronington' in 1976.

### Taffs Two Penn'orth

Life at the factory is still as hectic as ever with demand ever increasing. Dusty (he claims to be the oldest working engineer in the die-cast industry - aged 67) went on his first holiday in August since Oxford Die-Cast began, so we were unable to install our new moulding machine until September.

It's a smaller tonnage than our existing machine and took 48 hours to commission, but I'm pleased to say that it's run continuously thanks to Mike A and Mike B two of our other engineers.

We currently use two main types of thermoplastic moulding materials for the product that runs on this machine.

ABS -

Acrylonitrilebutadienestyrene

HIS - High Impact Polystyrene

These plastics accommodate most of our requirements, but we may introduce some more exotic materials in the fullness of time.

Over the next couple of months we will be looking at a variety of different coating processes and I'll let you know how we got on in the next edition of the 'Globe'.

# Geoff Boycott O.B.E. England



Geoffrey Boycott first appeared for England in the Ashes Test against Australia at Trent Bridge in 1964.

In total Geoff represented England on no fewer than

106 times - against 6 different countries from 1964 to 1974, and from 1977 to 1982.

He amassed an amazing 8114 test runs giving an average of almost 48 runs per innings! He scored 22 centuries and 42 half centuries. In fact he scored a century against every country he played against! His highest single score was 246 n.o. against India at Lords in 1967.

Geoff also carried his bat (in from start to finish not out) against Australia in Perth 1979 scoring 99 not out.

An icon in the cricket world, Geoff made his 100th century whilst playing in a test match at his home ground of Headingly, Leeds during the 4th test against Australia, and became only the 18th batsman in the history

of cricket to perform such a feat, and the very first to achieve it in a test match.

Geoff captained England on 4 occasions

On 23 December 1981 he passed Garfield Sobers record held for test runs scored.

Boycott played in 35 one day Internationals and won 4 man of the match medals.

He was awarded his O.B.E. in 1980.

This edition is 5000 pieces and the model is in England's traditional colours. Each comes with a personally signed certificate from Geoff.

This vehicle will without doubt be a highly collectable and sought after piece especially for cricket lovers world wide. Remember throughout the cricket world this man numbers amongst the greatest.

The cost of the vehicle like all 'Sporting Heroes' vehicles is just £5.95. It may be purchased on 4 for 3 and 6 for 4 only in combination with other 'Sporting Heroes' vehicles. It cannot be mixed with the general range.
