### 'North West Collection'



Following the introduction of the first Mini Classics Set, 'The Southern Collection', it appears we have a runaway success on our hands with many 'outside of club' enquiries for them.

The second set, 'Set 2' features 3 buses from up around the North West of England.

The 'Crosville' bus company established in 1910 by Mr. G Crosland Taylor and a Frenchman, George Ville. Crosville operated out of the glorious city of Chester, covering North & Mid Wales. 'Wallace Arnold' was established by none other than Messrs. Wallace Cunningham and Arnold Crowe and was originally based in Leeds with its coach tours and operations covering as far as Devon and London in later years.

The 'Seagull' was established in the early 20's with Charabancs operated along the Fylde Coast and inland areas.

The edition is 5500 sets of 3 buses in a display box and the new cost is  $\mathcal{L}9.95$  per set. Also the price of set 1 will now be  $\mathcal{L}9.95$  each.
