Every August, Scotland's capital undergoes a miraculous change with entertainment that is unmatched anywhere in the world. The story began in 1947 when the Edinburgh International Festival was launched. It was seen as a post war initiative to re-unite Europe through culture, and was so successful that it inspired more performers than there was room for. The Fringe is now 56 years old and the festival attracts almost a million visitors each year. To celebrate the event we have produced two Routemasters the RM50 - Edinburgh Festival and the RM51 - I Love Scotland, Both have been sold in Scotland during the Festival this year and we have available for our club members 400 of each livery. They come in a special window box and are not certificated, we produced in total 1,500 of the RM50 and

His name is now part of the English Language and was created to show him full of 'vigour and vim' because he breakfasted daily on FORCE, as remembered by the rhyme: High o'er the fence leaps 'Sunny Jim' Force is the food that raises him!

## FX4 Austin Taxi 1959

The FX4 taxi was first introduced in 1959; it was the next in line from the FX3 model. This taxi had an Austin 2.2 diesel engine, pull down door handles and "bunny" ears on the roof indicators. The modification over the years changed the taxi to push in door handles, no roof indicators and a 2.5 Austin engine. The FX4 taxi with the Austin 2.5 engine was manufactured between May 1974 and September 1982 this taxi was considered at the time to be the best taxi built. It was very easy to work on and the Austin engine was well known for reliability, good pulling power and a good workhorse. The FX4 did not have power steering, the front brakes were servo assisted, some of them came with a sunroof, some with vinyl and some with both. The public carriage office allowed radio to be fitted around 1982/83, this was roof mounted just below the for hire sign in the drivers compartment. The maximum speed of the FX4



automatic would now be about 55mph, You could expect to get about 23 - 25 mpg around town and about 5 - 6 mpg more on a run, the manual version would give you about 6 mpg more on both these

> amounts. Most of the Austin FX4 taxis that came into London were automatic with about only 1% having a manual gearbox. To try to work out how many miles an Austin FX4 taxi would have driven in it's life multiply the age of the taxi by 30,000 this would give you some idea. The engines would have been reconditioned during this time with some of them hitting 3/4 million miles. We'll be releasing several liveries based on this Taxi over the next 18 months. The first in the series is uncertificated and we have supplied to the airports as a tourist gift for a number of years.
