This casting will appear with this body finish as the MM032. The mould is being modified and later this year we will release it with a corrugation effect. This will be a different colour, probably a dusty blue, we have still to decide this. This is the fourth Morris Minor variant that we have released this year following on from the High Top, Gown and Ice Cream variants. We have designed a further Morris Minor variant, but will probably release this around December.

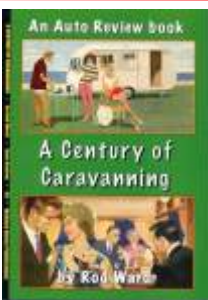
