Support vehicles became more important as services gained improved equipment and appliances trying to keep a pace with the risks imposed by new technology. The Anglia was suitable for the transportation of smaller items and incident support.

Hudson Road, just off Harehills Lane in Burmantofts - Leeds, used to be home to the biggest clothing factory in the world part of Sir Montague Burton's menswear empire. Around 10,000 people worked on the site, producing over 30,000 suits a week. Burton was the biggest employer around.

Hudson Road was the heart of Montague Burton's empire. He chose Leeds because it was the centre of Britain's textile industry and so he had access to skilled tailors and machinists.

Burton's secret was to offer high-quality made-to-measure suits at low prices. "A five guinea suit for 55 shillings", was Burton's promise. Men would start work at 14 years of age as barrow boys, then be apprenticed as tailors or cutters. There were vast workrooms of machinists, all women, with whole families working on the same production line. The factory was described by former tailor, Sam Bernstein, as "a town in itself". Burton made every effort to keep his staff happy - Hudson Road had the largest works canteen in the world, along with a pre-welfare state health and pension scheme. Free dentists, chiropodists and even sun-ray treatment were provided for factory staff.

As announced a few Globes back the CA will come in a whole range of bodyshells and we are trying out first casting shots at the moment - I will publish some shots in the next Globe. The HA will release as a van, window (Beagle), High Top, Camper Open, Camper Closed and a Batman Ice Cream variant. So a lot to look forward to. We are pushing further ahead with variants on the Chipperfields and also working on a further 1:43rd release for the latter part of the year. We are also pushing ahead with a new range for 2008 which forms part of our operation Bulldog. More details of this will be released at the end of quarter 4. I have finally succumbed and brought in some help, it was just getting too hard to cover everything. So Adrienne has joined us, she was originally with Corgi for 16 years and has diecast in her blood, like all of us at Oxford. I remember her father Don, who worked at Mettoy, he was a key part of their team back in the 1970's and early 80's and retired 6/7 years ago. So if I work a bit harder and Adrienne puts in the hours - who knows what we will achieve in 2008 - the game is just beginning and Operation Bulldog is starting - they are tough little dogs !
