

The Bedford CA is a brand new addition to our range, if you asked anyone in the early 1960's what was the most popular light commercial vehicle, then the answer would have been the CA. Ours is based on the 15 cwt series which was produced between 1959 and 1969 and we will be releasing it in a variety of bodyshapes. The first is a milk float, but we have many more to follow including a Pantechnicon, canopy pick up, van, minibus and of course an ice cream van.

The Bedford CA had a 90 inch wheelbase, quite small by todays standards so they launched a 102 inch version which was designated the CAL, hence the CA became known as the CAS.

TY-PHOO Better TEA

Typhoo was launched in 1903 by John Summer Jr following comments from his sister on the calming effects of tea fannings. The name Typhoo came from the Chinese word for doctor – "Dai Fu".

A few new members have queried the origin of our bus and details can be found in the "Journey Through Time" book, but it did not originate from the old Budgie moulds. It was developed from the Corgi patterns around 1984/1985 by Dusty, for Seener of London. Subsequently the moulds have been replaced and updated, the chassis being a different construction from the Seener original.

The Austin version of the Paralanian proved very popular, so here's a Morris version. These lovely coach built bodies were made by Central Garage who were based in Parry Lane, Bradford. We've had quite a few letters from members who have seen a modified JA005 appearing on the internet - a Chipperfields liveried version went for over £60 recently. This was a CODE 3 model - a vehicle from our range that has been converted without our knowledge. This is a common practice and we have no problems with conversions taking place, but of course we do not sell these models ourselves.









KLM was founded in 1919 and its first scheduled flight took place one year later from Amsterdam to London. During the war all KLM aircraft still operating had "Holland" painted in large letters on their fuselage to identify them as neutral. KLM is the abbreviation for, KONINKLIJKE LUCHTVAART MAATSCHAPPIJ which literally means Royal Aviation Company and in 2004 it merged with Air France.





The need for Austin to create uniform coloured vehicles across the country was very difficult, with local dealers adopting different styles. This led to various newsletters requesting the use of Austin Stone Grey, Austin Claret or Austin Blue. Slogans were also suggested, such as "You can depend on Austin Service" or "Express Spare Parts Delivery". Dealers were reminded that a well designed service vehicle will have a long term impact in the public.





Founded in 1897 as the Automobile Club of Great Britain, King Edward VII commanded that it should be known as The Royal Automobile Club. The Morris J2 joined the fleet of vehicles owned by the club in the 1960's and many radio rescue vehicles could be seen around the countryside.
