The Bedford HA is our newest release and a model that hasn't appeared in 1:43rd diecast previously. The HA van was very economical and sold well into the large fleets, notably the regional gas companies, the electricity boards, water authorities, British Railways and Post Office Telephones. Bedford had hoped that its new van would prove more popular than the Morris 1000 from the Royal Mail, but it didn't happen. The HA was also modified for a number of special applications, including a 'high top', which Martin Walter designed primarily for the garment trade. A good number of these were also sold to laundry companies, whilst several local authorities employed them in their 'Park and Gardens' departments. Camper versions soon appeared and firms like Morrisons,

Cummins and Archibold Scott converted them to ice-cream vans and burger bars. One of the oldest conversions to the HA was the offering by Cummins of Crewe, who produced the 'Batman' mobile.

This is the first release in the HA range and further information on the vehicle can be found in the Nostalgia Road series - Bedford Light Commercials, extracts of which are above.

Bermuda Morris Minor NEW

The Bermuda Police Service was created in 1879. Bermuda's only police until then, had been nine Parish constables (one for each Parish). These positions were filled by men appointed for twelve months unpaid service, until pay was introduced in the late 19th Century. These appointments



were compulsory. Dissatisfaction with the quality of this part-time Constabulary led to the formation of the Bermuda Police Force under the Police Establishment Act, 1879. The new body consisted of ten full time constables under Superintendent J. C. B. Clarke. Three of the constables were based in Hamilton with Clarke, three in St. George's,

with Chief Constable H. Dunkley, and two in Somerset, and there were still twenty-one part-time Parish constables. The size of the police force was trebled in 1901. The first Detective was appointed in 1919, and the Force underwent another reorganisation in 1920, with eighteen constables recruited from the UK raising its strength to forty-six. The size of the force grew steadily over the following decades. The Bermuda Reserve Constabulary was created in 1951. With the closure of the HM Dockyard and the attendant military garrison in 1958, Police Headquarters and other elements relocated to Prospect Camp, the former military heaquarters. A Womans' Department was established in 1961 with the first five female police officers. A marine section was formed in 1962.



Today the policing of Heathrow has totally changed from its earlier days, with major concerns over terrorism, drug and people smuggling. Back in the 1960's the focus was on crime and general security and the black and yellow vehicles were a familiar sight in and around the facilities. MV022 is based on the picture shown which was taken we believe around 1967.

Lyons started to make ice-cream in 1894 using the turbine bowl method. When refrigeration was further developed after the First World War production increased and automation helped to bring the product to a wider market. Unlike America, ice-cream in Britain was a seasonal phenomena with fluctuating sales depending on the weather pattern. With use of frozen carbon dioxide Lyons were able to ship their ice-cream from the Cadby Hall factory, by train, to most parts of the UK setting up cold stores at several rail-heads. Ice-cream sales continued to grow and new hand-held products were introduced such as the frozen ice-lolly. As with the other

parts of the Lyons group expansion of market share was all important and many smaller, regional ice-cream businesses were

purchased which included, among others, Eldorado, Neilson's, Midland Counties, Walkers Dairies, Tonibell and Bertorelli. This not only increased Lyons' market share of ice-cream,

but brought into the group new, local production facilities thus saving expensive refrigerated transport costs.

Tonibell Pink CA004 2000 £9.95 The very popular Tonibell livery on the Bedford CA in pink. Tonibell was started in 1937 by Italian-born Toni Pignatelli and his Scottish wife. Known as Tonis, it consisted of a small icecream manufacturing plant in a shop in the High Street of Middlesex. Their first mobile vehicle was purchased in 1951 - a tricycle fitted with a holdover box to carry ice-cream. A year later a small van was converted into a mobile ice-cream vehicle

Business expanded and the name was changed to Tonibell and over the years the company

changed hands many times and at its peak there were over 500 vans and 15 parlours.
