The Royal Mail fleet is still one of the largest fleets of vehicles in the UK. The use of mailvans expanded during the 1920's and 1930's, initially Fords, then Morris before a whole variety of other vehicles were used. Some of these were for test purposes only, whilst other were needed to fulfil specialist needs - Land Rovers for hostile weather and and rough terrain, large saloons for senior managers and Mobile Post Office Units for outlying areas. There are many good books on the subject and my favourite is the Royal Mail book issued by the Post Office Vehicle Club which has plenty of pictures covering the history of the Royal Mail fleet. The Bedford CA came in a wide variety of body combinations and the CA005 is based around the Grosvenor, Canopy Pick-up, which would have set you back £569 in the early sixties - around £8,500 at todays prices - and was very popular amongst the building fraternity. Martin Walters another coach builder was based in Folkestone, they carried out a wide range of popular conversions. In the coming months we will release a mini bus, which will further extend the range we have on offer which already includes milk floats, ice cream vehicles and vans.

Sir Julius Drewe was a self-made millionaire whose chain of Home and Colonial Stores enabled him to retire in 1899 at the age of 33. (only a few more years to go for Taff!) He had discovered that a Norman baron named Drogo de Teigne was his ancestor and was determined to build a castle on the acres that had once belonged to him. He chose a site near Drewsteignton, Devon, 900 foot above the Teign gorge the foundation stone was laid on Sir Julius' 55th birthday in 1911. His stores continued to prosper and our gown van is shown carrying advertising, boasting over 100 stores in the 1960's.







NEW TOOLING UPDATE

As promised in so many emails and letters here is a run down of the latest developments. The Land Rover 1:43rd scale vehicles are already being tried out, there are several modifications that are taking place to the chassis/wheel area - further tryouts take place end November. The new 1:76 cars are already completed, we have announced four variants (trial samples shown below) and we have another four that are already tooled and ready to run. The Chipperfield variants are all signed off, so we only await manufacture of these, four further TK variants (non Chipperfield) have also been designed and are in tooling - two of these being road vehicles and two promotional vehicles. The 1:43rd TX4 London Taxi has completed tooling trials and has been released to production. The 1:76 Scania modern trucks are going through tooling trials and a second cab unit has been approved and released into the toolroom. All new trucks will appear under the Bulldog brandname. A new as yet undisclosed modern rally car is in tooling for release towards the end of guarter 1 2008. A further 8 new items have been fully designed and are in the process of tooling. Over fifty new tooled products will appear in 2008, the full livery programme has been completed by Adrienne. Rob is currently working on 3:1 prototype samples of some new 1:76 models, which will take until around Christmas to complete. Martin is working on a brand new range that won't release until midyear, but needless to say it is very exciting, this will move us into further new territory as part of our strategy to compete across all sectors of the diecast market. The next couple of Globes will contain more information. So as this is the last Globe of 2007, it just means I'd like to thank you all for your support and wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. TAFF
