This month we have new castings, the Austins J2 Paralanian and the Morris J2 London ambulance. I didn't really think when I decided to launch these about the size of the Paralanian, it was so big it didn't fit the case, so we've modified the plinth with four cutouts, which means that this model

sits lower. The J2 range was announced in June 1956 with a wheelbase of 7ft 6 ins and rated at 15cwt. The van cost £554 and the 12 seater minibus £625, if you wanted heaters it would cost £11 extra. The cab had two front panel designs to provide the Morris J2 and Austin 152 version which was a policy adopted by BMC. The van could be specified with either sliding or hinged cab doors, single or sliding rear doors. By 1965 the Morris front panel was dropped and the Austin front panel was adopted for both versions. The name Paralanian derived from the road in which the coachbuilders were based - Parry Lane, Bradford and it was the first modern compact coach built motor home and many came with these two tone finishes.

Stephen Sanderson Transport was founded in 1973 by Stephen Sanderson, the business prospered and



it opened its first office in Market Harborough. Further expansion was needed and in 1978 the first depot was created based in East Farndon. Offering a workshop and a small warehouse, the business and fleet was able to grow. In 1983 they purchased property previously owned by Federated Road Transport Ltd. The company of Stephen Sanderson Transport Ltd was formed in February 1987. A further site was purchased in 1988 on the Riverside Industrial estate in Market Harborough where a purpose built depot was developed. By 2000 they were operating over 40 vehicles and employing up to 70 members of staff.

The roadster was the first of the MGB range to be produced. The body was a pure two-seater but a small rear seat was a rare optional extra at one point. By making better use of space the MGB was able to offer more passenger and luggage accommodation than the earlier MGA. Between 1962 and 1980 over 399,000 vehicles were produced covering the MKI to MKIII.

Rover chief engineer Maurice Wilks was inspired by his army-surplus Willys-Overland Jeep to create a workhorse vehicle for military and agricultural use. Prototypes were up and running by late 1947, and production of the Series I began at Solihull in summer 1948. The Land Rover price started from just £450. Supply to the British forces started in 1949, the Land Rover replacing the Austin Champ and later, the rust-prone Austin Gypsy, deliveries to organisations such as the Red Cross soon followed. The 100,000th Land Rover was made in autumn 1954 and by 1958, production ran to around 200,000

MECHANICAL HORSE

The Mechical Horse was a very simple and sturdy vehicle constructed on a steel channel frame with a cab made of wood, the early versions having canvas doors.

It came in two sizes, capable of carrying loads of 3-ton and six ton.

The vehicles were very manoeuvrable and had a road speed of about 20 mph and could do

between 10 and 20 mpg. They were used by quite a number of companies including the armed forces where they were used in stores and on aircraft carriers as well as with railway companies.

After the end of the Second World War, Scammell Lorries looked at the Mechanical Horse, which was basically

unchanged from its 1934 design, realised that something more modern was called for and set about re-designing the vehicle. Later Scammell offered diesel engines. These were the Perkins 4-199 for 3-ton and P4 and P4203 for six ton. The low mounting of the engine and other design changes made the Scarab more stable and its rounded all steel cab was more comfortable for drivers. The Scarab lasted in production until 1967.

ROUTEMASTER ROUND UP

As we start the introduction of our new range of N gauge Routemasters, we thought that it was time we gave you a round up of the releases of all the RM's that we have launched with Oxford over the last 10 years. The origins of our bus are fascinating. Back in the days of the Corgi factory (1985) Dusty was approached by Mr Seener of London to supply buses for sale in the tourist market. Seener already owned an FX4 taxi and a Rolls Royce mould, which had originated from Budgie. The Mettoy/Corgi product, the C469 was a little too expensive, so Mr Seener invested in his own set of moulds to produce a smaller bus, at 1:76 scale. Over many years the moulds deteriorated and Microlink invested in new moulds, eventually creating its own set of moulds. When we closed that part of the business in 1998 we integrated the Routemaster into the Oxford range. We supply this bus into the tourist market today. Stocks positions are shown, we cannot guarantee to fulfil orders for low stock items. Some were sold in different packs at a slightly higher price - so check out order form.
