By the mid-1950s, with Britain starting to recover from the Second World War, fuel was in short supply and petrol rationing was reintroduced. While sales of big cars slumped, there was a boom in more economical vehicles. The British Motor Corporation charged Alec Issigonis with designing something that would actually look like a car, hold four adults, and be small and economical. His design was a revolutionary space-saving front-wheel-

drive that for the first time mounted the engine transversely. Virtually all small front-wheel-drive cars that followed employed a similar configuration. First produced in 1959, the Mini soon became Britain's most popular car, enjoying its heyday in the Swinging Sixties. Now, five decades on, the Mini is celebrating its 50th anniversary. Oxford is releasing a specially packaged Mini to commemorate the event.

The first Postmaster of New South Wales was an exconvict, Isaac Nichols, who took the post in 1809 operating from his home in George Street, Sydney. His main job was to take charge of letters and parcels arriving by ship, to avoid the chaos of people rushing onto the ships as soon as they arrived at Sydney's wharves. The Postal Act of 1825 allowed the governor to fix postage rates and appoint Postmasters outside Sydney, enabling the first organized postal service, which grew throughout the country. By 1849 uniform postal rates were established by agreement between the colonies. Monthly steamship sea mail to the United Kingdom was

established in 1856. The separate colonies joined the Universal Postal Union in 1891. The demand for Oxford vehicles in Australia has grown rapidly in the last year, this is part of a release specially for their collectors – the registration code is ZPP 454.
