When we first announced the launch of the Daimler DS420, there was a lot of talk over whether we would release the Queen Mothers Daimler. Well here it is, a lovely car in Black and Claret carrying the registration plate NLT1.



The first of her five DS420s was purchased in May 1970 - car no 1M1559 (Vanden Plas job no. 12493). When her car was approaching the end of the production line, she visited the factory to watch its completion and to agree some of the finer design details. The car is very recognisable carrying the Royal Coat of Arms.

The Jensen Interceptor saloon had a distinctive large, curving wrap-around rear window that doubled as a tailgate. The original specification included electric windows, reclining front seats, a wood rimmed steering wheel, radio with twin speakers, reversing lights and an



electric clock. It was manufactured by Jensen Motors between 1966 and 1976, with over 6,400 being produced. The car broke with Jensen tradition by having a steel bodyshell instead of glass-reinforced plastic and by having the body designed by an outside firm, Carrozzeria Touring of Italy, rather than the in-house staff. The early bodies were Italian-built, by Vignale, before production by Jensen themselves began in West Bromwich.

It existed from the creation of BR in 1948 and ceased to be an operating unit in its own right in the 1980s being wound-up at the end of 1992.

The Morris Oxford was updated in 1956 with a new optional two-tone paint scheme, fluted bonnet and small rear fins. Inside the bench seats trimmed in leather remained, but the instrument cluster was revised and a new dished steering wheel fitted. The engine produced 55 horse power following an increase in compression ratio though the top speed and acceleration remained the same.

By the 1960's there were four main operating areas: British Road Services Ltd, BRS Parcels Ltd, Pickfords and Containerway & Roadferry Ltd.

The Postbus offers 'public transport' to areas where a commercial route is not available. Travelling a known route delivering and collecting mail, arriving and departing from set points and at roughly the same time on each journey.

Brothers Huw and Eurof launched their light haulage operations from Llanelli, South Wales, with one van in 1970. They carried furniture, kitchens and piano parts, they soon acquired two small lorries. Seven years later the flourishing company became Owens Road Services. Its blue-liveried trucks becoming a familiar sight on the roads of Wales. The fleet grew taking automotive loads onto the European mainland. In 1995 a warehouse operation was launched and it clinched its first major distribution deal with a supermarket, before joining the Palletforce network. The workforce grew to over 500, in recent years it has won major contracts - one to distribute goods used in building a huge new UK fuel pipeline, the other with global online retailer Amazon. Storage and warehousing improved with the acquisition of a large facility close to the M4 in Port Talbot. Expansion continued with the opening of Owens' first English depot - in strategically important Droitwich, Worcs.
