## NEW HAVEN DINING CARS



The New Haven offered extensive food service on its trains, but after World War 2 found itself relying almost exclusively on older heavyweight diners to cover these services. As part of their postwar investment in stainless-steel passenger cars, the New Haven Railroad purchased ten full 48-seat Dining cars from Pullman-Bradley. The new diners were delivered in 1949.

Like the Parlors and coaches that had been delivered earlier they carried with stainless-steel sides and ends and Hunter green window bands and roof. When delivered the cars carried skirting along the bottom of the car sides. They were repainted into the McGinnis scheme with an orange window band in the mid-1950s with most losing their skirting shortly afterwards.

The diners served the New Haven until the Penn Central merger in 1969. None asted long enough in Penn Central service to receive PC paint.



# The Rapido Trains Inc. HO Scale FA-2 and FPA-2 was widely regarded as one of the best locomotive releases of 2017, so we are very pleased to reveal our highly anticipated second run of the classic Alco/MLW cab units.

This second run has something of a 1960s flavor and loads of new to Rapido roadnames as well. To cater for this expansion into new territory we've tooled up additional body styles and loads of extra road specific details too. That's Rapido, eh! Oh yeah, and we're making the Alco/MLW B unit (FB-2 and FPB-2) as well!

The new body styles aren't minor cosmetic changes. We've made brand new non-dynamic brake bodies to accurately represent the large Louisville & Nashville and Missouri Pacific FA-2 and FPA-2 fleets. The L&N was the third largest owner of FA-2s, FB-2s and FPA-2s with 58 units in total, while the Mopac fleet of Alco cab units was second only to the mighty New York Central, with 102 units on the roster. This included 19 FPA-2s, making it Alco's largest customer for the dual-service version

The L&N FAs, along with the Ann Arbor/ Wabash units, also feature the repositioned headlight in the nose door, with oscillating

PENN CENTRAL 50TH ANNIVERSARY

To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the formation of the Penn Central railroad, we are offering three PC locomotive in two paint schemes. PC 1302 and 1373 are ex-New York Central "Cigar Band" FA-2s with new PC numbers, while PC 1350 was the only unit to be repainted in all-over black with the short-lived red "P" logo.

Gyralite in the usual headlight position. Meanwhile, the unique Chicago and North Western pair have a large red Mars emergency light in the nose door, while the Western Maryland units have a unique nose with MU doors and ventilation louvers.

As usual, we can't help ourselves when it comes to road-specific details. New to this production run includes extra horns, a crazy variety of grab arrangements, the L&N's additional underbody battery boxes and distinctive nose side ladders, plus spark arrestors, sunshades, and other parts designed to accurately represent these units at specific

periods in their two decades of service.

All that said though, the best thing about this new production run though might just be that the American retail price remains unchanged, even though we first announced FA-2 locomotives nearly three years ago!

So if you thought your old FA-2 models were "good enough" and you decided to sit out the first release, I hope we've managed to convince you to think about picking up a Rapido FA-2 or FPA-2. Not convinced yet, here's what Model Railroad News wrote about our model:

From head to toe, Rapido has done its homework and the FA-2, and its 1:87 renderings are easily the best and most authentic reproductions of the Alco-GE prototype to ever run on HO-gauge rails, period.... Rapido has once again hit it out of the ballpark; the company's new HO-scale Alco FA-2 is a home run indeed.

We've had many requests for all of these paint schemes, but to be honest we've never done most of them before so we're not sure what the demand is. To that effect, many of the schemes are conditional upon us receiving enough orders to meet our minimums.



The new FA-2 and steam generator-fitted FPA-2 locomotives were launched at the end of 1950, with the B-units being almost identical with the exception of the lack of cab and position of the battery compartment.

Montreal Locomotive Works (MLW) was responsible for the manufacture of locomotives under licence for Canadian National and Canadian Pacific as well as a batch for Ferrocarriles Nacionales de México.

Unlike their American cousins, the Canadian fleet of 244-equipped MLWs lasted a few years longer, with CP especially wringing as much of the life out of its units as possible. The majority of CN's fleet had disappeared in the 1960s, although two examples, 6758 and 6759, were both rebuilt to FPA-4 specifications and survived into VIA Rail service. The last CP examples were withdrawn in 1977 having survived well into the classic Multimark era.



However there were a few notable examples of FB-2s that were constructed to supplement existing fleets of FA-1 cabs. The New Haven was the most famous railroad to only buy FB-2s (see above), and we've added the whole fleet of five units to our range, in two paint schemes!

The fortunes of the FB-2 and FPB-2s mostly mirrored the lives of the A-units and most lasted well into the 1960s, with a few notable examples keeping theirs right to the end of Alco/MLW cab unit operation. This included a sizable fleet of New York Central and New Haven Bs that were still working into the first

Alco/MLW built around 230 B-units which were years of the Penn Central. One FB-2 was even repainted PC black, which we're offering as a special PC 50th anniversary release. In Canada the Bs lasted even longer with Canadian Pacific's fleet eventually being retired in 1977.

> It's a common misconception that B units always ran with the same A unit. However, by the end of the 1950s, the Alco/MLW B-units were mixed and matched, and regularly operated not only with other A units but with totally mismatched hood units as well. So even if you didn't buy our A-units, you can still buy an FB-2 and amaze your friends and relations!

> The FPB-2 differs from the FB-2 in that it has a steam generator for providing steam heat to passenger cars. The key spotting differences

are the larger combined underbody fuel and water tank and the exhaust panel on the roof.

Our Alco/MLW Bs feature the same amazing level of detail as our A units. Just like the FA-2, there were substantial variations of the FB-2 or FPB-2 locomotives from railroad to railroad as well as during construction by Alco at Schenectady or MLW (Montreal Locomotive Works). EP-5 Electric Lecomotive



THE NEW HAVEN'S EP-5s are one of the most famous electric locomotives in North America. Built by General Electric, the ten-strong class was delivered in 1955 dressed in the colorful McGinnis red, white and black paint scheme with large "NH" logos on the sides and noses.

The EP-5s were state-of-the-art for their time, being equipped with ignitron rectifiers to convert the AC power from the overhead wires to DC for use in the locomotive's traction motors. They also carried third rail shoes and DC auxiliaries to allow operation on the third-rail system into New York City's Grand Central Terminal. Crammed full of electronic equipment, the locos weighed 174 tons.

#### Shore Line "Jets"

The EP-5s were put into service in the New Haven's electrified Shore Line route between New York and New Haven, Connecticut. They very quickly they earned the nickname "Jets" because of the sound of the blower motors need to cool the ignitron rectifiers.

Their flashy paint scheme combined with their operation in a highly populated area meant that they quickly became well-known.

Like any locomotive in regular service, the "Jets" were modified over their service lives. The first modifications came shortly after delivery when large vents were added to the sides of the otherwise smooth bodies. These provided extra cooling for the mass of electrical components within the cramped carbody. The pantograph shoes were modified from a double shoe design to a single shoe at about the same time.

units had FRA-mandated nose grabs and walkways applied. At about this time the paint scheme was modified slightly with the nose "NH" being reduced in size and the nose road number increased in size and moved onto the nose from its previous location at the top of the anticlimber. Side skirts around the fuel and water tank were also removed at about this time.

#### **Penn Central survivors**

Several EP-5s continued in service after the Penn Central merger in 1969 while others were stored. The PC transferred some units to former

PRR territory where they were used in freight service. The last "Jet" was retired in 1977, shortly after the formation of Conrail. All ten units were scrapped.


