





The H-16-44 series was Fairbanks Morse's attempt to compete in the growing hood-unit market in the 1950s. Built between 1950 and 1963, the H-16-44 offered 1600 HP from its 8-cylinder opposed piston diesel engine. 209 units were built for US railroads and 58 for Canadian roads.

In 1955, Fairbanks Morse updated the design for their H-16-44 locomotives. These changes involved raising the walkway & simplifying the design of the short & long hood to make construction easier. From the outside the locomotives looked much like their bigger brother – the H-24-66 "Trainmaster" but with 4 axles instead of 6. Under the hood the locomotives were nearly identical to the earlier phases of H-16-44 except for replacing the Westinghouse Electrical System with a more reliable General Electric system. These "Phase III" units are the basis for Rapido's new model.

A total of 165 of the H-16-44 Phase III Locomotives were built between 1955 and 1963. Locomotives for the Canadian Pacific Railway & Canadian National Railway were built by Fairbanks Morse subsidiary Canadian Locomotive Company. The last H-16-44 was built for the Ferrorcarril de Chihuahua al Pacifico Railroad in 1963. This was the last Fairbanks Morse Locomotive to roll off the assembly line as the company folded the same year.



It has been quite a while since we've offered these popular cars for sale, and it's about time that we did some more! We are offering new road numbers on some of the most popular schemes from the earlier runs, as well as an all-new HO release.

The Rapido HO scale wood reefer is based on a design built between 1937 and 1941 by General American Transportation (GARX). Although built with a wooden sheathed body and roof that made them look like a car from an earlier era, these GARX cars were modern for their time. They were constructed on a steel underframe of similar construction to boxcar underframes then in common use and featured AB brakes, Equipco brake wheels and housings and Barber S-I trucks. More than 940 cars were built to this configuration making it one of the most numerous meat reefer designs, and they lasted in service well into the early 1970's. They would normally be assigned to meat service only, running between meat packing houses and regional dealers throughout North America, Including Canada.

Many people missed the first runs of these highly-detailed freight cars because they sold out so quickly. The third run is sure to do the same. Reserve yours now!





EP-5 Electric Lecomotive



**THE NEW HAVEN'S EP-5s** are one of the most famous electric locomotives in North America. Built by General Electric, the tenstrong class was delivered in 1955 dressed in the colorful McGinnis red, white and black paint scheme with large "NH" logos on the sides and noses.

The EP-5s were state-of-the-art for their time, being equipped with ignitron rectifiers to convert the AC power from the overhead wires to DC for use in the locomotive's traction motors. They also carried third rail shoes and DC auxiliaries to allow operation on the third-rail system into New York City's Grand Central Terminal. Crammed full of electronic equipment, the locos weighed 174 tons.

### Shore Line "Jets"

The EP-5s were put into service in the New Haven's electrified Shore Line route between New York and New Haven, Connecticut. They very quickly they earned the nickname "Jets" because of the sound of the blower motors need to cool the ignitron rectifiers.

Their flashy paint scheme combined with their operation in a highly populated area meant that they quickly became well-known.

Like any locomotive in regular service, the "Jets" were modified over their service lives. The first modifications came shortly after delivery when large vents were added to the sides of the otherwise smooth bodies. These provided extra cooling for the mass of electrical components within the cramped carbody. The pantograph shoes were modified from a double shoe design to a single shoe at about the same time.

In the early 1960s the units had FRA-mandated nose grabs and walkways applied. At about this time the paint scheme was modified slightly with the nose "NH" being reduced in size and the nose road number increased in size and moved onto the nose from its previous location at the top of the anticlimber. Side skirts around the fuel and water tank were also removed at about this time.

#### **Penn Central survivors**

Several EP-5s continued in service after the Penn Central merger in 1969 while others were stored. The PC transferred some units to former PRR territory where they were used in freight service. The last "Jet" was retired in 1977,

shortly after the formation of Conrail. All ten units were scrapped.

### The Rapido EP-5 Locomotive

Developed with help from the New Haven Railroad Technical and Historical Association and noted EP-5 expert, Rick Abramson, Rapido's HO Scale model features a full range of detail options that will allow accurate depictions of the EP-5 throughout its service life.







In 1934 the Pennsylvania Railroad started production of a new series of 40' boxcars – the X31 series. These cars featured an unusual round roof appearance to provide maximum capacity within the then standard loading gauge.

The most numerous group of these new boxcars was the X31A, produced in both single and double door variants. In total, the PRR produced 7200 X31A boxcars, with another 2000 cars being produced to similar classes X31B and X31C. This made the X31 series the second most numerous series of PRR boxcar after 1949. There were more X31 boxcars than many railroads had entire freight cars of all types!

These cars traveled throughout North America and could be seen literally anywhere until the mid 1960s when age and attrition took their toll. Even so, more than 1000 were still in service at the time of the Penn Central merger, though most were retired quickly afterwards.
